Services	Fees	Description of Services
Intake / Referral	\$250	All new clients of Camp Zip must have an intake in person. Includes meeting with the client on their abilities, skills, employment history, and potential barriers.
Fitness Classes	\$50	Most classes are an hour long that are Cardio Drumming or Yoga. Besides the focus of fitness being part of a healthy lifestyle, adults will also focus on proper hygiene, nutrition, community participation, active listening and appropriate dress for a fitness class
Cooking Class	\$150/ per Class	Campers will get a monthly cooking class where they learn skills in an industrial kitchen where they will get a chance to practice job skills. They will also learn a recipe that they can prepare independently that focuses on good nutrition.
Zip Saturday "Count Me In"	\$150/Per Week	Weekly focus of a different theme that will revolve around social skills and independent living. Campers will enjoy these skills as they focus social/interpersonal skills while finding ways to access the community
Social Skills in Community	\$2250	5 Week Course (3 hours a week) that focus on workplace readiness skills in and out of the community. The course will build skills in: • teamwork • communication • problem solving • cooperation • active listening • decision making • conflict resolution • body Language • professionalism • good manners • respect Campers will use these skills in the community in real life scenarios and situations like: • using a cell phone • using transportation • money management • nutrition/meal preparation • accessing community • civic responsibility • community safety • developing friendships

Services	Fees	Description of Services
Transportation Training	\$75 / Hour	Clients will be taught and set up all available transportation options from their residence. This could include: Bus, Taxi, Uber, Lyft, or Waze rideshare.
One Week Employment Boot Camps	\$5000/ Per Camper	All inclusive one week overnight at area hotel. Can be set up anywhere in State of Michigan. Campers will be set up with resumes, job applications, interviews, job experiences, BRIDGE Cards, CMH Person Center Plan, and family plan to make next steps for transition. Campers will also get transportation training, life skill training and recreation planning. Last camp, 6 out of 10 campers left with a paid job by the end of the week.
Weekend Overnight - Employment Workshop	\$1750	Campers will stay overnight at the Howell Nature Center for the weekend to focus on a toolkit to prepare for employment. Job skills, life skills, resumes, applications, employment cheat sheets, and much more.
Self Advocacy Training	\$200 hour	Clients will get one on one sessions to prepare for they self advocacy with focus on the following:
